

In 1976 at an international meeting of women squash administrators in Australia, Mrs Jill Eksteen of South Africa was invited to act as chair of the inaugural body formed to establish the Women's Squash Rackets Association. The Women's Squash Rackets Association was officially recognised from 1978.

iv On 21st February 1992 Unity between the South African Men's Squash Rackets Association, The Women's Squash Rackets Association of South Africa and the South African Squash Rackets Federation was signed in Johannesburg. This was the culmination of 15 months of constructive debate co-ordinated by a Steering Committee chaired by Advocate Rob Wise.
